The People Had A Personal Desire To Honor God

Exodus 25:2 “You are to receive an offering for me from everyone whose heart prompts them to give.”

Lit = to volunteer from the heart

2 Cor 9:7 “Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give.”

The People Had A Passion For The Work

Exodus 30:15 “...make the offering to the Lord to atone for your lives.”

Lit = *a covering, or a redemption price*

1Pet 1:18-20 “*For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your forefathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect*”
